RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF LAKE TAHOE BASIN WILDFIRE AWARENESS MONTH, "THINK FIRST—KEEP TAHOE FIRE SAFE," JUNE 2017

WHEREAS, wildfire is a serious threat to Lake Tahoe's environmental, social, and economic well-being; and

WHEREAS, visitors and residents of fire-prone communities at Lake Tahoe must take responsibility for living and recreating in high fire-hazard areas; and

WHEREAS, June 2017 is Wildfire Awareness Month and marks the 10-year anniversary of the Angora Fire; and

WHEREAS, people living and recreating at Lake Tahoe must take important precautions to help prevent wildfire ignitions; and

WHEREAS, residents and property owners at Lake Tahoe must create defensible space and take other important steps to create fire adapted communities and prepare in advance for Lake Tahoe's next wildfire; and


